TRAVEL CAMPER CONDUCT AGREEMENT

This form must be signed by both the camper and parent and returned prior to attending camp.

To ensure a safe and successful summer for all of our campers, Meadowbrook has established the following additional rules for all campers in a Meadowbrook Travel Program. These rules supplement the policies in the Meadowbrook Parent Handbook. All rules are definite and will be strictly enforced. Violation of any of Meadowbrook's rules will result in a camper's dismissal from camp with no refund or credit of tuition.

I understand that my behavior, conduct and attitude are critical to my enjoyment of camp and the enjoyment of others. I further recognize that I am responsible for creating a safe and comfortable camp community for all campers and staff associated with this program. Therefore, I agree to abide by the following rules:

1. I will treat everyone I come in contact with, Meadowbrook campers and staff, as well as employees and other customers of the places we visit, with respect and courtesy.
2. I will be respectful of the property of others and care for it as if it were my own. I will not borrow or take anything that is not mine. If my actions cause damage to any property, including hotel rooms and buses, my parents will be responsible for paying the cost of any repair.
3. I will be aware of the daily schedule and be on time for all group check-ins. On overnight trips, I will remain in my room and not open my hotel room door after curfew. I will take responsibility for bringing home all notices regarding trips, late returns and overnight trips so that my parents are informed of my plans.
4. I will immediately notify a Meadowbrook Staff Member of any problems, issues or unsafe situations. This includes information relating to the health, safety and welfare of anyone in the group.
5. I will not break any municipal, state or federal laws including shoplifting or the possession or use of any tobacco, illegal drug, weapon or alcohol.
6. I will not participate in any behavior that is disruptive or unsafe. This includes, but is not limited to, ignoring the requests of staff, ignoring posted rules at places we visit, making fun of other people, gossiping, swearing, using inappropriate or threatening language and making prank phone calls.
7. I understand that cell phones are not permitted in camp and will be confiscated immediately. I have also received, read, understand and agree to follow the Meadowbrook Cell Phone Policy for Travel campers. Camera phones are NEVER permitted in camp or on trips.
8. I will be responsible for my personal belongings and will not hold Meadowbrook or any other outsider responsible for loss or damage.
9. I will remain with a Meadowbrook Staff Member at all times except when given explicit permission to be with another camper or group of campers. I will never leave the group on my own.
10. I will ALWAYS wear my Meadowbrook T-Shirt/Sweatshirt visibly when traveling out of camp on trips.
